

Del.icio.us

1. ***** **OPEN 2 BROWSER WINDOWS** *****
(1 for email and the other for Del.icio.us)

2. **REGISTER**
 - Username
 - Password
 - Email

 - Install Buttons (may have to go back later on home computer to install buttons. Go to “Help” / “Buttons.”

 - Go to Email to retrieve your verification email (click on the link provided).

 - Go back to window with Del.icio.us and refresh the browser.

3. **HOME PAGE**
 - Click the button at the bottom left corner to return to homepage at anytime (or use buttons installed during registration).
 - HOTLIST = Zeitgist in Library Thing. The most popular items.
 - POPULAR = Today’s most popular saved items.
 - RECENT = Most recent saved items (*Click Refresh to see it updated*).

4. **ADD LINKS**
 - Open a new window.
 - Use the buttons installed during registration (“post to delicious”).
 - If they are not there, click “post” on the top of page and type in the website address.
 - Add tags and notes (***Uses spaces, not commas like Library Thing***)

5. NETWORK

- ADD:

*Can also add users to network when viewing their collection. There will be a link called “add user to your network” at the top of the page.

- Send a Link:
 - ❖ for:techtracks
- Save a network user’s favorite to your own.
View their favorites, choose one your like, click “save.”

6. SUBSCRIPTIONS

- ADD:
 - ❖ Library2.0
 - ❖ Flickr

*Can also subscribe to a username to be updated on what they add daily. (Great for workspaces)

*Can also add or edit from the “Settings” link.

7. LINKS FOR YOU

- Where users can send you recommended links (What we did before with for:techtracks).
- Show link sent by jboller.
(Have teens find reviews for books they want and send them to library)
